Stonington Kennels, Inc. has been in operation as a full-service boarding and grooming kennel since 1978, owned and operated by Carolyn Hamilton.

The kennel is located in a country setting on ten beautiful acres, halfway between Clarkston and Davison.

Our goal for each and every pet is that Stonington Kennels is their second home and our staff is their extended family. To accomplish this we interact with the pets during the day through play and petting.

We offer all-breed dog and cat boarding, and on occasion rabbits, birds, hamsters, and even skunks have vacationed with us.

DOG BOARDING

Each dog has its own 4' by 4' inside bedroom, with a see-through door that leads directly to its own 4' by 10' outside covered run. All inside and outside runs are washed down and disinfected daily. Water is available at all times. Music is played continuously to provide a pleasant, relaxed atmosphere. Bedding is provided by the kennel. Owners may bring special treats if they desire--in labeled Zip-lock bags

During the cooler months, inside rooms are maintained at 70 degrees and dogs are exercised in their own individual outside runs four or five times per day, beginning at 7 am and ending at 11 pm. During the warmer months kennels are cooled by a combination of natural ventilation and central air conditioning and the dogs' doors remain open during the day to allow them to run in and out as they wish.

If desired by the owner, a dog can be given extra brushing or go for a romp in the field for an additional charge.



Complimentary Bath

Dogs that stay with us for seven or more charged nights receive a complimentary bath before they go home.

WALK AND PLAY

If desired, for an additional charge, your dog may be taken for field walks and play sessions.

CAT BOARDING

The cats are maintained in a room separate from the dogs. Each cat has its own apartment with food, water and litter box, which is cleaned and changed as needed. Each feline

Please bring in pet 1/2 hour prior to closing so that we can get it settled in.

PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS

Boarding rates are based on a nightly charge up until 11:00 am on the day the pet goes home (like a motel). There is a two day minimum charge. Check out time is before 11:00 am. If you pick up your pet during hours we are open after 11:00 am you are charged for that coming night. First time clients are required to pay when the animal is brought in for boarding. Returning clients may pay their bills at the end of the boarding stay.

We accept payment by cash and personal checks only. There is a \$20 charge for returned checks.

HOLIDAY* RESERVATIONS

All holiday* reservations require a credit card to guarantee the reservation. Reservations may be cancelled or changed up to two weeks before the start of the holiday boarding. If, for any reason, the kennel assigned to a dog is empty, the client is responsible for each day's payment through the time reserved. The credit card will be charged and a receipt will be sent to the client.

GROOMING

We offer all-breed grooming and are fully equipped to handle both large and small dogs at Stonington Kennels, Inc.

All grooming is done to the specifications of the owner unless the condition of the coat does not permit this.

COMPLETE GROOMING

- Bath
- Creme rinse (if necessary)
- Fluff dry
- Final brush out
- Final clip and scissoring
- Rough-clip (or brush out)
- Toe nails trimmed
- Ears plucked
- Anal glands emptied

OPTIONAL SERVICES

- Bath only
- Flea and tick dips
- Nail Trims



Feeding and Medications

High quality dry and canned food is available for both the dogs and cats. Special food and prescription diets will be fed and medications administered only if supplied and packaged by the owner (see below). All pets are fed in the morning, with second meals, if requested, served in the afternoon. A bisquit is given at bedtime. There is an additional charge for dispensing medications more than twice daily. All the dishes that the animals use are supplied by the kennel and are washed and disinfected daily.

Instructions for Packaging Food and Medications:

Each day's total amount of food is to be packaged individually in its own zip-lock plastic bag and labeled with the following information:

1. Pet's name
2. Pet's breed and color
3. Owner's last name
4. Feeding instructions (wet, dry, canned meat, etc.)
5. Indicate if the pet is to be fed once or twice a day.
6. Bring all the bags of food in a grocery bag labeled with the same information as on the individual meal bags.

All medications must be in 7 day pill boxes and clearly labeled with the following information:

1. Pet's name
2. Pet's breed and color
3. Owner's last name
4. Dispensing instructions

Required Vaccinations

We require all current inoculations for each animal brought onto the property. These vaccinations must have been given at least 48 hours prior to the animal's stay.

WHERE WE ARE LOCATED

TRAINING

Our instructors have many years of experience in training dogs in obedience and in teaching classes for both adults and children.

We offer two types of programs for training your dog. They include:

- **CLASSES** - Small groups of owners and their dogs learn basic or advanced fundamentals from experienced instructor.
- **PRIVATE LESSONS** - The owner and the dog work with our professional instructor and is given lessons to practice at home. .
- All training is done in a 40' by 80' heated Training Barn or fenced-in fields.

The Training Barn is also available for rent for obedience or breed matches and seminars.
